It is with regret that following new Government guidelines there will be no congregational (Jammah) prayers including Jumm'uah until further notice. This will be effective from Fajr Thursday 5th November 2020. The Masjid will be open for individual prayers, see timings below.

TIMINGS

We will consistently be reviewing the opening times and will advise further if there are any changes.

- Every Morning between **6.30am to 7.30am**
- Every Evening between **5pm to 6.30pm**

Under NO circumstances should congregational prayers be performed when you attend the Masjid for individual prayers.

PLEASE SEE THE BELOW GUIDELINES THAT WE ASK ALL ATTENDEES TO FOLLOW

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Following Government guidelines, if you fall into any of the categories below you are strongly advised not to attend the Masjid.

- Anyone aged 70 or over and anyone with underlying chronic illnesses
- If you have a temperature (>38C), dry cough, or cold and flu like symptoms
- If you are frontline staff with increased exposure or shielding
- You have underlying health conditions e.g. Respiratory illness, severe illness, High Blood pressure, Diabetic
- Young children under the age of 12

BEFORE YOU ATTEND, YOU MUST

- Perform Wudhu at home as Toilet and Wudhu facilities will NOT be available
- There are no Qurans, Tasbeeh and chairs
- Bring your own full-size prayer mat and face mask

AT THE MASJID, WE KINDLY ASK THAT

- **No private congregational prayers to be performed at the Masjid**
- Maintain social distancing at all times and sanitise your hands upon entry and exit
- Respect that only a limited number of attendees will be allowed in the main prayer hall at one time
- No socialising within the masjid or outside the masjid
- Please follow and respect the guidance of the volunteers
- Familiarise yourself with signs and posters around the masjid
- If you are unsure of anything, please ask a trained volunteer
